## **Research Analysis**

HB 1907, as introduced, requires portable and medium format battery manufacturers to submit a battery stewardship plan to the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality by June 1, 2026 and operate under the plan by January 1, 2027. A manufacturer's batteries are prohibited from being sold unless they are in compliance with their plan. The plan must detail the provisions for collecting those batteries, among other things.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1907 outlines a battery stewardship plan to be followed by certain battery manufacturers and to be administered by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). According to DEQ, the agency projects the need to add one FTE at an estimated recurring cost of Ninety-Eight Thousand Twenty Dollars and Sixty-Eight Cents (\$98,020.68) to fulfill the requirements of this measure.
