**Research Analysis**

HB 1939 as introduced, directs that the Legislative authorization for any turnpike project authorized prior to, on, or after November 1, 2025 is to expire unless actual physical construction has begun within five years of November 1, 2025 or after the effective date of the authorization. The measure provides for Legislative reauthorization of an expired turnpike project.
