Research Analysis

The policy committee recommendation for HB 1955 clarifies that the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability can pay up to \$1,800 of selected teachers' National Board certification costs. If a teacher does not complete the certification process, they will be required to re-pay any amount money received. The measure also clarifies that all teachers seeking initial National Board certification can participate in the Education Leadership Oklahoma mentoring program for up to three years.
