**Research Analysis**

The policy recommendation for HB 1958 allows a school board to submit an affidavit to the State Department of Education as proof that the board took a specific action instead of submitting approved board minutes. Such affidavit shall be signed and sworn by the applicable personnel and include other specific information listed in the measure. The measure does not exempt a school board from keeping minutes in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.
