Research Analysis

HB 1992 requires law enforcement when arriving at the scene of an accident involving a combination vehicle to report that the vehicle is a combination vehicle and is subject to removal by nonconsensual tow. The measure clarifies that the additional twenty-five percent gross profit markup or gross profit margin is chargeable by the wrecker operator whether or not the wrecker operator pays for specialized labor or equipment up front.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1992 requires that certain vehicles involved in accidents be considered combination vehicles. The measure further provides clarification for when certain additional fees may be charged and replaces the Oklahoma Tax Commission with Service Oklahoma regarding agency responsibilities. The measure merely transfers certain responsibilities from one state agency to another. Any administrative costs associated with implementation of the measure are anticipated to be minimal and absorbed by existing agency resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
