Research Analysis

HB 2011, as introduced, creates the "Fighting Chance for Firefighters Act," which allows cancer centers in Oklahoma to carry out the purposes and functions of the act to cover the costs of occupational cancer screenings. For taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2026, there will be allowed as a credit against Oklahoma Income Tax equal to the amount of unreimbursed expense at the maximum of \$250 a tax year incurred by a firefighter for the costs of medical procedures to detect any form of cancer. This credit may carried over to each of the five subsequent income tax years. The total amount of credits authorized to offset tax will be limited to \$1.5 million. The measure also allows the benefits of the Oklahoma Employees Insurance and Benefits Plans to employees of municipal and county fire departments.
