The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 2021 allows the Department of Human Services (DHS) to award grants to community-based organizations that run after school programs. The organizations must have at least five locations in the state. DHS is authorized to promulgate rules for implementing the program.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2021 creates the Oklahoma Kids After-School Grant Program (OKAGP) within the Department of Human Services (DHS). The program will award grants to entities that operate after-school programs for children in kindergarten through 12th grade and have at least five locations in Oklahoma.

DHS is authorized to promulgate rules for implementation and the Oklahoma Kids After-School Grant Program Revolving Fund is established within the Department. In its current form, HB 2021 does not have a fiscal impact, as there is no appropriation to the Fund; thus, having no impact on the state budget.
