## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2052 provides that notwithstanding any other provision of this title, domestic health maintenance organizations that contract with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to provide basic health services to Medicaid recipients are only subject to the benefit coverage criteria and regulations of the Medicaid program and are exempt from the listed and expanded provisions in the measure. These exemptions only apply to the services provided to Medicaid recipients pursuant to Section 4002.2 of Title 56 of Oklahoma Statutes.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

This bill provides certain exemptions to health maintenance organizations that help provide care to Medicaid recipients. According to both the Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the Oklahoma Department of Insurance, this measure should not create a fiscal impact for either agency.
