**Fiscal Analysis**

The subcommittee recommendation to HB 2057 modifies apportionments of the medical marijuana tax within the State Department of Health. The measure reduces the allocation earmarked for drug and alcohol rehabilitation from 6.15% to 5% and reallocates 1.15% to the Trauma Care Assistance Revolving Fund. This modification does not impact the General Revenue Fund, thus having no impact on the state budget.
