**Research Analysis**

HB 2069 as introduced, repeals [Title 21 Section 1755](#), which relates to injury to toll house or turnpike gate and [Title 47 Section 11-806.2](#), which relates to exceeding speed limit in properly marked toll booth zone. In effect, the measure removes the felony violation for maliciously damaging a turnpike toll booth. The measure also removes the requirement of doubling fines for drivers charged with speeding in a toll booth zone.
