Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 2071 prohibits the intentional release of chemicals or other substances into the atmosphere with the express purpose of affecting temperature, weather, or the intensity of sunlight.

The measure also repeals the following sections of law:

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2071 prohibits certain actions related to weather modification as well as repeals several sections of statute related to the Oklahoma Weather Modification Act and the Weather Modification Division at the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB). Per the OWRB, this program has no dedicated staff or appropriated funding dedicated to its administration; therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
