## **Research Analysis**

HB 2084, as introduced, provides that if an electrical contractor or journeyman does not complete their required 12 continuing education hours within three years of license renewal, any hours completed during the expired period will count toward the requirements for the period before the license expired. The license can be renewed once the continuing education and any other requirements are met. After renewal, another 12 hours of continuing education will be needed for the next three-year period.
