**Research Analysis**

HB 2085, as introduced, authorizes the Uniform Building Code Commission to establish a regional continuing education and training process for all construction industry workers affected by code adoption. The training will have no cost for state-licensed building code officials, but a fee may be assessed to all other participants. The commission must also establish a workforce development process to increase the number of code officials in the state.

Additionally, the measure removes the commission from within the Construction Industries Board and decreases the required experience for the inspector member of the commission from 15 years to 10 years.
