Research Analysis

HB2106, as introduced, revises the scheduling of local and special elections by:

- Moving the first election date from the second Tuesday in February to the first Tuesday in March.
- Replacing the first Tuesday in April with the third Tuesday in June.
- Adding an election on the fourth Tuesday in August, replacing the prior provision for elections on any regularly scheduled statewide election date in even-numbered years.
- Moving the odd-numbered year September election from the second Tuesday to the first Tuesday.
- Eliminating the second Tuesday of November in an odd-numbered year and rescheduling special elections to fill vacancies from the second Tuesday in June of an odd-numbered year to a date “after the first Monday in November.”
