**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute modifies the date for elections currently held in September from the second Tuesday of September to the third Tuesday of June in any year. The date for elections in November has been updated from the second Tuesday of November to the fourth Tuesday of August in any odd-numbered year.

The measure further provides exceptions for when the Governor can call a special election outside of the regular election dates, and provides specific circumstances under which additional dates are allowed, and provides dates on which the election can be held.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2106 modifies dates upon which certain elections may be held. Functionally, the measure reduces the number of overall election dates. The measure does not mandate any action or expenditure by state agency, and any resulting costs are expected to be minimal and absorbed by existing budgetary resources at applicable agencies.
