HB 2108 as introduced, updates several statutory references in the Oklahoma Employee Insurance and Benefits Act. Major updates include replacing any reference to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, date clarifications, and decapitalizations.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2108 modifies the Oklahoma Employee Insurance and Benefits Act by replacing certain references to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA). Such modifications transfer administrative responsibilities for state employee insurance and benefits programs from one state agency to another. The measure effectively aligns statutory language with the current organizational structure of state government. After communication with OHCA, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
