**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 2109 clarifies that Ethics Commission is to maintain county and school district statements of organization and reports of contributions and expenditures for four years regardless if they were posted on the entity's website or not. Additionally, the floor amendment clarifies that the Ethics Commission can post school district statements of financial interest on their website and gives the Ethics Commission the authority to destroy or retain statements of financial interest after four years.

HB 2109, as amended, centralizes campaign finance and financial disclosure filings for municipalities, counties, and school districts under the Oklahoma Ethics Commission.
