**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB2117 adopts the Uniform Collaborative Law as recommended by the Uniform Laws Commission. The act allows parties to voluntarily use a collaborative law process to resolve a dispute or issue without intervention by a court or other tribunal. The act lists the requirements to enter into and dissolve a collaborative law participation agreement, outlines the role of collaborative law lawyers in these proceedings and addresses the confidentiality of communications made during a collaborative law process.
