HB 2152, as introduced, raises the gross annual sales of a business that qualifies as a home food establishment from \$75,000 annually to \$300,000 annually. The measure removes the prohibition on using unpasteurized milk in homemade food products and requires that if the product consists of unpasteurized milk that the label and the placard indicate as such.
