Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 2156 creates setback requirements for solar energy facilities and industrial battery storage facilities. The facilities must be:

- 500 feet away from any occupied structure or occupied residence, unless waived by the occupant;
- 100 feet away from the outer boundary of the facility property;
- 100 feet away from any public road right of way;
- 1.5 miles away from the center line of an airport, public school, or hospital; and
- 2 miles away from a wildlife refuge, or body of water used by migratory waterfowl.
