HB 2159 prohibits the manufacture, distribution, selling or installation of counterfeit supplemental restraint systems components and nonfunctional airbags. Violations are punishable as a misdemeanor.

HB 2159 establishes misdemeanors relating to the manufacture, importation, distribution, sale, or installation of certain supplemental restraint systems.
