## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure as currently written is not anticipated to result in a negative fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations. However, there is a potential revenue loss for the higher education institutions.

Estimates provided by the State Regents for Higher Education and the Regional University System of Oklahoma indicate that there could be a potential revenue loss of \$500,000 per 1% of the participating population that opts out of the meal plan.
