HB 2215 removes the authority of law enforcement to seize the license plate of a motor vehicle when issuing a citation for violation of the Compulsory Insurance Law. The measure also removes various fees that are subsequently charged to a person attempting to retrieve the license plate.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2215 removes certain provisions relating to uninsured vehicle tag seizures. The Oklahoma Department of Public Safety (DPS) has not received funds from such seizures since FY-22, which equaled a total of approximately \$3,000. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
