Research Analysis

HB2218, as introduced, creates the Local Music Incentive Act of 2025 to allow eligible venues that host local music performances to receive a partial rebate of sales and mixed beverages taxes collected by a venue during a 24 hour period. Eligible venue may claim the rebate for sales occurring 12 hours prior to the scheduled start time of an eligible performance and the following 12 hours after the start time. The rebate is limited to once every quarter and the rebate percentage depends on the occupancy limits of the venues. Venues that can accommodate 300 people or less can receive a 25 percent rebate of taxes collected whereas venues that can accommodate between 300 and 600 people may receive a 50 percent rebate.
