Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 2262 provides that a referral agency provide a representative of a person with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia who is considering placement within a unit, program, or facility, the disclosure form for each recommended facility. The facility must display in the designated area a complaint poster that states they may file a complaint with the Attorney General's Consumer Protection Unit if they were not given a copy of the disclosure form.

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2262 specifies the requirements for referral agencies and dementia care facilities in relation to the disclosure of care documents within the Alzheimer's Dementia and Other Forms of Dementia Special Care Disclosure Act.
