**Research Analysis**

HB 2268, as introduced, provides that the Oklahoma Medicaid Program or contracted entity must provide reimbursement for such benefits delivered through cognitive assessment and care planning services.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2268 requires the state Medicaid program and its contracted entities to provide reimbursement for cognitive assessment and care planning services. According to OHCA officials, assuming a 25% to 50% utilization, the anticipated state share to cover these services ranges from One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$189,621) to Seven Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars (\$758,484).

Therefore, HB 2268 could have a fiscal impact of up to \$758,484 on the state budget.
