### **Research Analysis**

HB 2285 as introduced, creates the Evacuation Vehicle Access Corridor (EVAC) Grant Program and revolving fund for the purpose of creating evacuation corridors for residents that live in areas with only one or less publicly owned roads providing access in or out of the area. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation is to administer the grant program.

### **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2516 in its current form, creates the Evacuation Vehicle Access Corridor Revolving Fund and Program (EVAC), within the Department of Transportation. The Program establishes a grant program to provide funding to develop multiple evacuation corridors in geographically landlocked basins of the state.

The measure as drafted creates a Program and Revolving Fund but contains no funding. Funding amounts would be directed in future legislation in amounts as determined appropriate by the Legislature. For these reasons HB 2285 in its current form has no direct impact on the State Budget or Revenues.
