### **Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 2294 provides that rules for community residential living for persons with physical or developmental disabilities be promulgated by the Department of Human Services. The pcs requires the Department of Human Services to promulgate rules within 180 days of the effective date of the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental or Physical Disabilities Act.

HB 2294 requires the Department of Human Services to promulgate rules which may encompass limitations on where new group homes are permitted but are not required to do so. The measure requires the Department of Human Services to promulgate rules that address the group home and resident matters listed in statute within 180 days of the effective date of the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental or Physical Disabilities Act.
