Research Analysis

HB 2295, as introduced, provides that no hospital license can be transferred from its current address to an address greater than 15 miles away, if the hospital license is located in a community with a population under 30,000. If a hospital facility announces a closure, a mediator must be appointed before the closure. The city must also appoint a mediator if the hospital is in city limits, otherwise, the county appoints a mediator. The two mediators will appoint a mutually-agreed upon third mediator and all three will agree upon a sales price for the license, if the hospital and municipality cannot reach an agreement without mediation. The hospital license will be purchased and transferred to the city or county if they are willing to pay the agreed-upon price.
