## **Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 2302 reduces the number of rows DPS is authorized to use for a large vehicle inspection station from two rows to one row.

HB 2302, as amended, designates certain parking spaces on the Oklahoma State Capitol grounds to be assigned by the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The measure also authorizes the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to use the southernmost row of parking spaces in the south parking lot of the Oklahoma State Capitol grounds for a large vehicle inspection station. DPS is allowed to post signage regarding the large vehicle inspection station along Lincoln Boulevard and at the gatehouses for both the Senate and the House of Representatives. All unassigned parking spaces in the south parking lot and the parking lot east of the Oklahoma State Capitol Building on the east side of Lincoln Boulevard are reserved for visitors.
