If efforts to assist the inmate in obtaining a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License fail, the Department of Corrections is required to assist the inmate in obtaining a REAL ID Noncompliant Identification Card.

Fiscal Analysis

HB2364 transfers from the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to ServiceOK duties to coordinate with the Department of Corrections in providing certain IDs to indigent discharged inmates. Each agency involved expects minimal administrative costs in implementing the provisions of the measure, and will be absorbing such costs with existing budgetary resources. Therefore, in its current form, HB2364 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
