Research Analysis

HB 2387, as introduced, amends membership for the Commission for Rehabilitation Services by increasing membership from three to seven. Members will serve three year terms, which will begin on July 1 and end on June 30 three years later. The current House appointee will serve until June 30, 2025. The current Governor appointee will serve until June 30, 2026. The current Senate appointee will serve until June 30, 2027. During that time, more members will be appointed by each party to expand membership to seven.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2387 expands the Commission for Rehabilitation Services from three (3) members to seven (7) members. Commission members serve without compensation; however, they are eligible for reimbursement for travel expenses. Therefore, the increase in membership is anticipated to have a minimal impact on the state budget, if any, with the impact solely dependent on additional travel expenses incurred.
