**Research Analysis**

HB 2422 would allow a sex offender who is eligible for parole to elect to receive hormonal treatment as a condition of parole. A sex offender who does not continue hormonal treatment or receives another treatment to reverse the effects of the hormonal treatment, or commits subsequent offenses is no longer eligible for parole and is subject to imprisonment.
