Research Analysis

The policy committee recommendation to HB 2459 exempts mobile food vehicles that did not have an automatic fire extinguishing system prior to July 1, 2024 from the requirement to install them according to current code, as long as they have portable fire extinguishers installed in their vehicles. A six liter Class K-rated portable fire extinguisher is required for all cooking equipment involving solid fuels or vegetable oils, animal oils, or fats. All liquified petroleum gas is to be inspected by the Oklahoma Liquified Petroleum Gas Board or a certified contractor. Additionally, the measure requires the State Fire Marshal to inspect and issue operational permits annually to mobile food vehicles. The provisions of this measure expire July 1, 2026.
