**Research Analysis**

HB 2606 directs the District Attorneys Council to develop and implement a five-year Domestic Violence Forensic Exam Pilot Program, subject to the availability of funds, in counties with a population of more than 100,000. The program is to provide counties with qualified licensed health care professionals to conduct domestic violence forensic exams. The measure creates a Domestic Violence Examination Fund in each participating county. The measure authorizes the Crime Victims Compensation Board to pay up to \$200 for a domestic violence forensic exam.
