The floor amendment to HB 2673 clarifies that no money collected before May 25th, 2021 is to be counted towards the \$18 million total the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture Supplemental Revolving Fund must reach before any expenditures can be made.

Fiscal Analysis

The adoption of FA1 would not change the impact of the measure as described below:

HB 2673 in its current form, modifies the provisions within an existing revolving fund, allowing for utilization of the existing balance of the revolving fund.
