**Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation for HB 2696 requires a public educational institution to release all student records to a parent upon request, or to the student if they are 18 or older, in accordance with the Open Records Act. The records must be released in a timely manner and free of charge. No information may be redacted or omitted unless including it would violate the law.
