HB 2705 directs law enforcement agencies to inform sexual assault victims of the status of forensic evidence upon request. The sexual assault victim has the right to be informed of whether a DNA profile was obtained, if the profile was entered into the Combined DNA Index System Database (CODIS) and whether or not a confirmed match was found in CODIS.
