Research Analysis

HB 2713 requires law enforcement to seize motor vehicles which are not bearing a proper license plate or if the annual registration is more than 60 days expired. The measure also increases the fine from \$1 per day for late registration to a penalty of \$100. An additional \$100 is to be assess for each 30 days following the first assessed penalty up to a maximum of \$1,200. All of the penalties assessed are to be deposited in the Department of Public Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund. The measure provides a 3% discount for persons who register within the two-month time frame for registration on the initial registration of a vehicle. Person's renewing registration prior to expiration of their registration are to receive a \$20 discount from the 2nd through 16th registration.
