**Research Analysis**

The policy committee substitute to HB 2713 requires law enforcement to seize motor vehicles which are not bearing a proper license plate or if the annual registration is more than 60 days expired. The measure also increases the fine from \$1 per day for late registration to a penalty of \$100. An additional \$100 is to be assessed for each 30 days following the first assessed penalty up to a maximum of \$1,200. The measure apportions the assessment. Any assessment greater than \$100 is to be deposited to the Department of Public Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund.
