Fiscal Analysis

The POLREC to HB2720 creates the Targeted Violence Prevention Act and sets forth duties to be carried out by the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security, the Oklahoma Counter Terrorism Intelligence Center (OCTIC), and the Department of Public Safety. In its current form, DPS anticipates needing to hire one additional FTE at a cost of \$134,000 annually to administer salary and benefits. DPS may seek additional funding to defray these costs.
