HB 2735, as introduced, exempts the Oklahoma Accountancy Board from following certain licensure requirements if an applicant has pending criminal charges or a conviction relating to embezzlement, extortion, fraud, false pretenses, forgery, or other crimes of dishonesty.

HB 2735 exempts the Oklahoma Accountancy Board from standard procedures when assessing the criminal histories of applicants whose offenses involve dishonesty or fraud. The exemption is not anticipated to have a direct impact on the state budget.
