Research Analysis

HB 2759 as introduced, creates the Oklahoma Volunteer Firefighter Support Program and revolving fund. The purpose of the grant program is to help volunteer firefighters receive up to 10 hours in training a year from programs approved by the State Fire Marshal or by ODAFF. The State Fire Marshal is tasked with creating the grant application system and promulgating the program rules.
