Fiscal Analysis

HB 2804 clarifies the prohibited acts of ABLE Commission licensees by stating no licensee shall *knowingly* receive, possess or sell any alcoholic beverage except as authorized by the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act and as specified by the license held. In its current form, HB 2804 is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
