Research Analysis

HB 2832 as introduced, requires ODOT to maintain a digital map that identifies all honorees of the Memorial Highways and Bridges Program. The location descriptions and reasons for designation must also be included in the map. Upon funding, ODOT must equip the map with interactive multimedia capabilities so that it can be shared with the public and with the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation to help promote the state. Additionally, all military honorees must be identified in a Veterans Military Trail Segment within the interactive map.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure requires the Department of Transportation (ODOT), to maintain an interactive digital map of the locations under the Memorial Highways and Bridges Program. After reviewing that bill, ODOT believes that it will cost the agency Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to develop and maintain the map. As ODOT is an appropriated agency, it will need an appropriation of \$500,000 to cover the cost to maintain the map.
