**Research Analysis**

HB 2834 requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to expand Medicaid coverage for Medicaid services or programs for in-home physical, occupational, and speech therapy to 96% of what Medicare coverage pays.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2834 requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to expand Medicaid coverage for in-home physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy to ninety-six percent (96%) of what Medicare coverage pays.

Officials from OHCA anticipate an impact ranging from \$1,484,140 to \$2,481,073 for expanding coverage of physical therapy, occupation therapy, and speech therapy services. Additionally, the rate increase will have a state share of \$548,159.

Therefore, the total anticipated fiscal impact ranges from \$2,032,299 to \$3,029,232.
