Research Analysis

The full committee amendment for HB 2836 adds that a veteran may voluntarily waive their right to free services and pay an upfront fee, provided that the written waiver is signed and acknowledges that the veteran understands that free services are available and provided that the upfront fee is refundable or paid to an organization with a minimum rating of "A" from the Better Business Bureau.

Fiscal Analysis

The HB 2836 creates the Safeguarding American Veteran Empowerment Act, which provides guidelines for advising on veterans' benefits for compensation. The requirements of the measure are not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
