Research Analysis

HB2836, as introduced, titled the Safeguarding American Veteran Empowerment Act, this measure establishes guidelines for individuals and businesses providing compensated services related to veterans' benefits matters. Guidelines include definitions, restrictions on compensation, prohibitions, mandatory disclosures, privacy and security requirements, enforcement and penalties, and an accredited representative exemption.

The Oklahoma Attorney General will oversee enforcement of this Act.
