**Research Analysis**

HB 2838, as introduced, creates the "Oklahoma Certified Meat Processing Facility Incentive Act of 2025," which creates the Oklahoma Certified Meat Processing Facility Incentive Approval Board and outlines the membership of the board. The measure outlines requirements that an eligible business entity must meet to be eligible of any payment of funds from the revolving fund. The State Auditor and Inspector will have the right to examine the books and records of any entity receiving incentive payments. The measure also creates a revolving fund for ODAFF.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2838 creates the Oklahoma Certified Meat Processing Facility Incentive Approval Board to provide incentives to certified meat processors to operate facilities within the state. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (ODAFF) currently does not believe this program would result in any additional administrative cost for the agency. This measure also creates a revolving fund for the program but not does appropriate any money to the fund; therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
