Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 2872 requires the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA) to take certain actions before proposing any new turnpikes or modifying an existing turnpike.

Those actions include:

- Giving notice to all affected property owners, which is to include certain information as laid out in the measure;
- Allowing for a 30 day comment period to submit data, views, or arguments after a publication of intended action on a turnpike project;
- Scheduling a hearing on any proposed turnpike project or modification of an existing project within 30 days of the closing of the public comment period and communicating with the public the date and place the hearing will take place;
- Considering the effect the proposed turnpike project or modification of an existing project could have on property owners, businesses, and governmental entities;
- Considering the effect the proposed turnpike project or modification of an existing project could have on consumer groups;
- Requiring OTA to provide the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives with a copy of the complete map of any new proposed turnpike project; and
- Communicating with the public where copies of proposed turnpike projects can be obtained for review.
